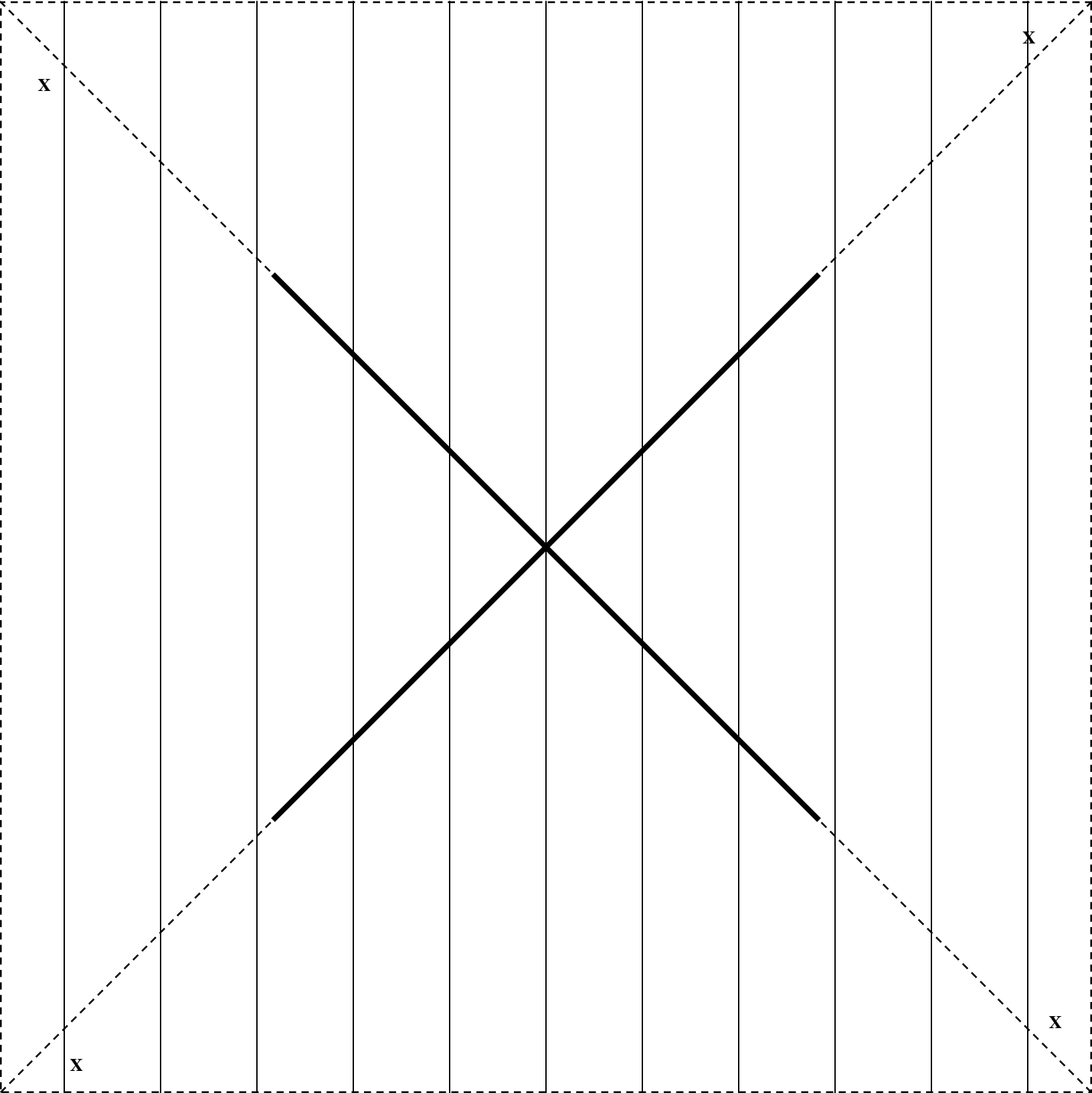


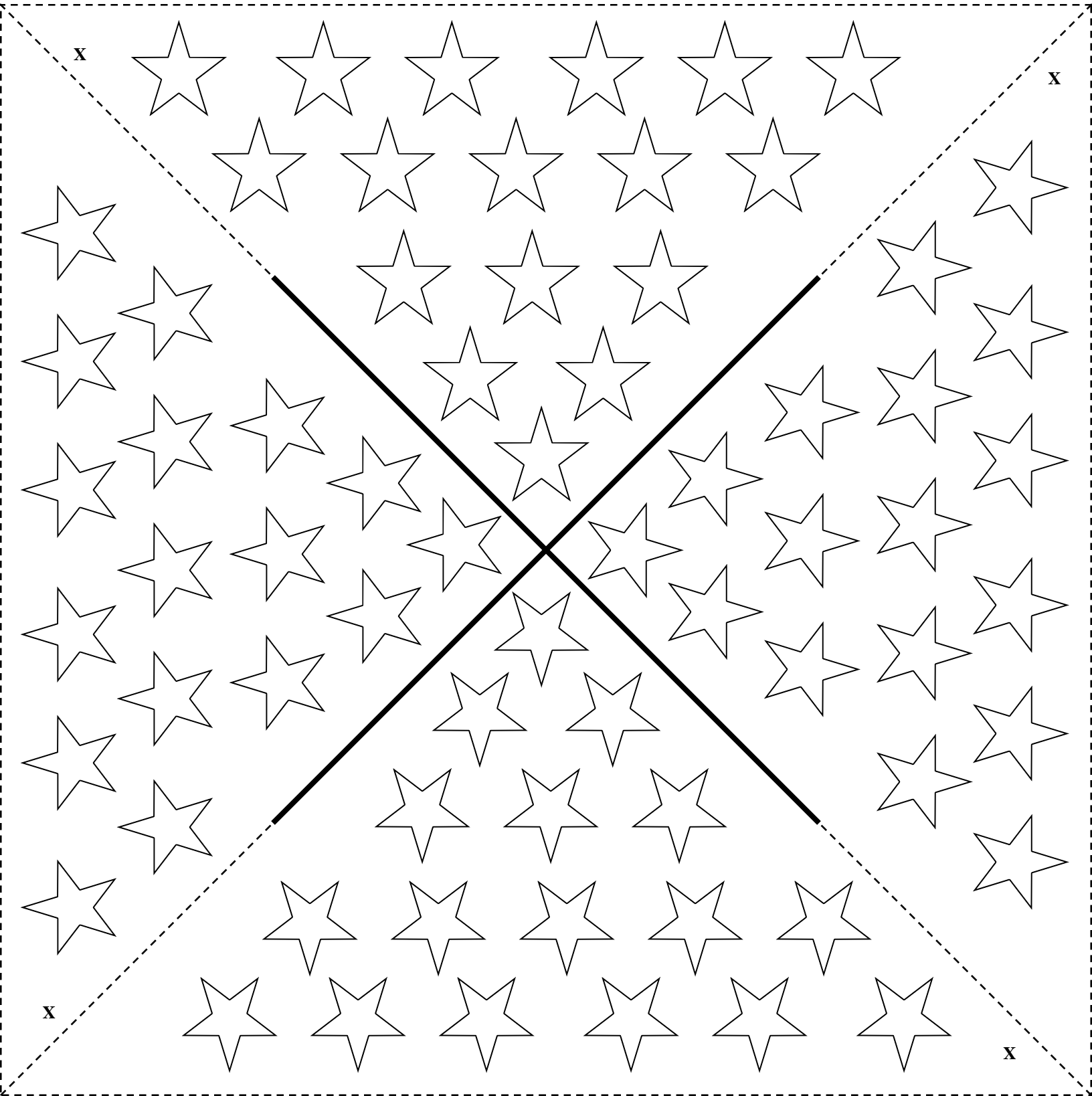

# AMERICAN FLAG PINWHEELS

- Print the previous pages on 8 1/2 X 11 paper
- Use markers or crayons to color your pinwheel.  
For a traditional look:
  - Page one—Color every other stripe red
  - Page two—Color background blue
- Cut out along the dotted lines
- Place the two pieces back to back, with colored side out
- Look for the small “X” at the points of pinwheel. Gently fold both piece of paper over (create a soft fold, do not crease the paper) and bring the points to the “X” at the center of the pinwheel. Do not fold points without an “X”
- With the help of an adult, place a push pin through the center of the pinwheel, securing all the points in place.
- Attach the pinwheel to the top of a pencil by pushing the push pin through the eraser.
